

Advanced Standing, Part-Time, Off-Campus Program Schedule (cohorts prior to 2016)

The Advanced Standing, part-time, off-campus MSW Program consists of two years of coursework and field, including summers. Students will complete a curriculum including the Advanced Standing Transitional Seminar and concentration courses. A sample schedule is provided below.

Individuals and Families Concentration Courses:

Summer Session I

- 5001 (3) – Advanced Standing Transitional Seminar
- 5700 (3) – Advanced Social Work Assessment

Summer Session II

- Choose 5810 as a Crossover course OR take an Approved Elective (3)*

Fall Year 1

- 5710 (3) – Advanced Social Work Practice with Families
- Choose 5820 as a Crossover course OR take an Approved Elective (3)*

Spring Year 1

- 5730 (3) – Advanced Social Work Practice with Children and Adolescents
- Choose 5840 as a Crossover course OR take an Approved Elective (3)*

Summer I and II

- Complete Approved Elective courses if needed*

Fall Year 2

- 5740 (3) – Advanced Social Work Practice with Adults
- 5720 (3) – Individuals & Families Field Practicum & Seminar I – 16 hours a week with seminar twice per month

Spring Year 2

- Choose 5850 as a Crossover course OR take an Approved Elective (3)*
- 5750 (3) – Individuals & Families Field Practicum & Seminar II – 16 hours a week with seminar twice per month

Summer I

Spring Year 1

- 5840 (3) – Nonprofit and Public Human Services Administration
- Choose 5730 as a Crossover course OR take an Approved Elective (3)*

Summer I and II

- Complete Approved Elective courses if needed*

Fall Year 2

- Choose 5740 as a Crossover course OR take an Approved Elective (3)*
- 5830 (3) – Community & Organizational Practice Field Practicum & Seminar I – 16 hours a week with seminar twice per month

Spring Year 2

- 5850 (3) – Community and Organizational Cultures
- 5860 (3) – Community & Organizational Practice Field Practicum & Seminar II – 16 hours a week with seminar twice per month
